

Trip Insurance

Trip insurance is highly recommended! And if you want to be covered for pandemics (like COVID-19), you will want to purchase **Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR)** insurance. Fewer companies are offering this type of policy given COVID-19 and you will want to do your own research. Ibex does not endorse any particular company but the below companies offer CFAR (in addition to the Travel+Leisure link in Lynn's article):

Important note: You will need to check your individual policy, but generally, CFAR needs to be purchased within 14-21 days of making your initial deposit and you must cancel at least 48 hours prior to the start of the trip. Trip insurance is an individual decision but in light of the last 6 months, it is worth considering.


